The objective of the Westminster Christian Academy Financial Aid program is to assist families who have a demonstrated financial need and are unable to afford the full cost of tuition. Applicants may apply for financial aid by visiting Grant & Aid Lafayette.

Which grades are eligible?

The program is available for students in K5 through 12th grade.

Is there a fee to apply?

Yes, FACTS charges a non-refundable application fee of \$40 upon submission.

When does the application open?

For current families, the application opens the <u>1st week of January</u>. For new families, the application opens <u>February 1st</u>. An application for admission must be submitted prior to applying for WCA Financial Aid.

When is the deadline?

WCA accepts applications until funds are exhausted. Funds are generally exhausted by **September**. Please check with the Business Office if you are interested in applying after this date to check if funds are available.

How long does it take for FACTS to review my application and send it to WCA? It typically takes FACTS two weeks to verify an application once all documents are uploaded. It is important to note that once you submit your application, FACTS will email you with a list of requested documents.

Once verified, FACTS will notify WCA that your application is ready for review.

When and how will I be notified if I have been awarded financial aid?

Financial Assistance is offered in the form of annual grants, which are determined by the Financial Aid Committee after an evaluation of the applicant's financial need. Notification of financial aid (if any) will be sent through FACTS Grant & Aid. Applications are reviewed in rounds and awarded by the end of each month beginning in the month of **March**.

What documents will be required to be provided to apply for Financial Aid?

Required documents will depend on your individual financial situation, but typical requested documents include: Federal Income Tax Return, W-2 or Federal Form 1040 if self-employed, Supporting documentation for household non-taxable income such as child support, etc.
